About the Camp Reporter Role

Your Tasks & Responsibilities

As our camp reporter, you are the person who records the experiences of the week and shares these with our guests across our social media, blogs and other channels. You are someone who has got the equipment and experience to take photographs of people's experiences, edit these photographs if needed, and share them with guests and followers. You are someone who doesn't shy away from writing about these experiences in a fun, friendly and engaging manner. Knowledge of SEO and Google key works a massive plus.

Your social media contribution helps to give future guests an understanding of what our camp looks like, and what happens at our camp on a daily basis. This also means that for our daily Instagram stories, we aren't looking for slick edited versions of the camp, but a realistic reflection of what the camp experience is about.

Among your responsibilities are:

- Photographing the camp activities, including ensuring you have taken photographs during surf lessons of each surf group, during the social evening activities or afternoon workshops, and during the weekly day trips;
- Upload and share the media with our guests via social media on a weekly basis;
- On a daily basis you share photo and video experiences at the camp on the social media, e.g. through Instagram story, Facebook etc.;
- You write 3 short blogs per week to be posted on our website and social media platforms;

Please note, you'll be working at the camping site, which means that infrastructure isn't always as great we'd like it to be, and use of internet for uploading could require patience at times. For sharing social media stories, we expect you to use your own equipment and data, but for sharing the larger files with guests, camp internet will be available. We also expect you to bring your own photography equipment. As camp reporter, you'll report directly to the Camp Manager. Your working hours fluctuate, depending on conditions to photograph and when activities take place throughout the week. Nonetheless, there should also be plenty of time to enjoy the camp life!

Two Photographer & Social Media locations in 2020

- **Photographer & Social Media Oyambre** - You are responsible for photographing and running social media at our beautiful camp in Spain, located at 10 minutes walk from the beach and surrounded by lots of nature. The camp hosts approx. 150 guests/wk at peak.

- **Photographer & Social Media Moliets** - You are responsible for photographing and running social media at our main camp in France, which hosts approx. 150 guests/wk at peak in our main camp and 70 guests/wk in the Surf & Yoga camp.

Among your benefits:

- √ Joining the surf camp activities (mostly for free); including our weekly wine & cheese nights, free use of the surf and yoga equipment, and joining the surf & yoga lessons when available.
- √ Private tent with mattress at the camp
- √ 5 dinners, 7 breakfasts, 7 picnic lunches per week
